## *Sparkling Wines, Prosecco, Cava, and Champagne*

- C02 Veuve Clicquot Brut Champagne France (375ml) Yellow Label \$47 Gold Label \$62  
YELLOW Hints of toast and biscuit accent lightly honeyed flavors of quince, apple blossom and peach in this fresh and balanced Champagne. There's a stony underpinning, with a smoke-tinged finish
- C03 Veuve Clicquot Brut Champagne France (750ml) Gold Label \$128 Yellow Label \$88  
GOLD The nose is very open, pure and complex. The Chardonnay gives this wine a refined mineral flavor accompanied with pleasant flowery notes of acacia. Aerating the wine reveals hints of yellow-fleshed fruit and pastries (brioche, marzipan)
- C06 Mumm Cuvee Napa Valley California \$55  
Elegantly styled, with floral apple and yeasty spice aromas that lead to layered flavors of baked pear, citrus and vanilla.
- C08 Moet & Chandon Imperial Champagne France \$81  
Elegant golden straw yellow with amber highlights. Its aromas are radiant, revealing bright yellow-fleshed fruits
- C09 Champagne Gatinois Tradition Brut Grand Cuvee France (375ml) \$38  
Fresh entry, opening out on the midpalate to present a creamy, enveloping style, with biscuity-yeasty tones.
- C12 Bisol Jeio Prosecco Italy \$31  
A very light and fresh nose here, with clean, white, floral fruits. Rather a bright style on the palate, only just off-dry, with a firm and dense character.
- C13 Kila Cava Spain \$28  
Estate bottled and aged over 12 months on its lees, this is a lovely sparkler from Vins El Cep in Penedes.  
A bit fruitier and riper than most cavas
- C14 Michel Arnould & Fils Grand Cru Champagne (375 mL) \$36  
Ripe and zesty fruit aroma begins focused on fruit, apples and lemons and a hint of honey, with Pinot "milk chocolate"

## *Large Format Bottles..Great for large Parties and Celebrations*

- L01 Caymus Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 Napa Valley **Magnum** \$220  
Scarlet color and brackish edges. Nose is sweet fruit and smoked meats. This wine already has some bouquet- truffle mushrooms, vanilla style oak. The palate is creamy richness with nuances of leather and a cocoa-style fine grain tannin.
- L02 Flora Springs Trilogy Napa Valley California 2004 **Double Magnum** \$425  
This vintage is still delicious! Big nose with red fruits hints of leather. Medium body with a soft mouth feel and a finish that lasts.  
The red fruits come though in mixed berry and cherry coupled with leather. Enjoy with Steak and Blue Cheese.
- L03 Kamen Cabernet Sauvignon Sonoma Valley California 2005 **Double Magnum** \$559  
Intense on the palate, revealing full-bodied flavors (sweet black raspberries and black currants), silky tannins, beautiful fruit depth, and a long finish.

D09	Quinta do Infantado Medium Dry Tawny Porto	Glass	\$11
	Dried and candied fruits and nuts dominate the nose of this fine Port. Medium in sweetness (not as sweet as many Tawnies) with an intriguingly complex mouth-feel. The finish is long and sweet, but also nicely balanced.		
D10	Quinta do Infantado LBV 2004 Porto	Glass	\$12
	The Infantado LBV 2004 currently shows lots of blackberry, licorice, and raisin notes.

R101	Jordan Cabernet Sauvignon Alexander Valley California		\$101
	Jordan Cabernet Sauvignon exudes beautiful, dense, blackberry aromas that echo through the mid-palate. The mouthfeel is silky-smooth with soft, round tannins accented by a vanilla quality from aging one year in primarily French oak barrels.		
R102	Silver Oak 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley		\$119
	Casual elegance defines this California classic. It's an herbal cabernet, with scents of grape skins and black olives rising out of the earthy tannin. Round and smooth in the middle, this ends with a clean and gentle feel.		
R103	Chateau D'Agassac 2005 Grand Vin de Bordeaux		\$69
	From what many have called the greatest vintage ever in Bordeaux. Full-bodied and rich, but drinking perfectly at the moment. Black currant, new French oak and spice		
R104	Perrin and Fils 2007 Les Christins Vaqueyras France		\$55
	From what most have called the greatest vintage in 35 years, comes this very full-bodied wine. Loaded with roasted cherry fruit and spice.		
R105	Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Artemis Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley		\$99

generous in flavor and velvety in texture. Aromas of cassis and caramel rise and give way to earthy notes of black olive, black pepper, and truffles. Classic flavors of cassis and black cherry fill the mouth as notes of violets and vanilla linger on the finish.

- R106 Mocali Brunello di Montalcino “Super Tuscan” Italy \$78  
A Tuscan classic! Plenty of oak keeps all that rich cherry fruit, leather and spice in balance.
- R107 Shafer “one point five” Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley \$126  
Aromas of pure, elegant black fruit, dark chocolate, and spice, followed by rich, juicy flavors of blackberry and black cherry, chocolate, and cedar, with ripe, smooth tannins and a long finish.
- R108 Caymus Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley \$114  
Scarlet color and brackish edges. Nose is sweet fruit and smoked meats. This wine already has some bouquet- truffle mushrooms, vanilla style oak. The palate is creamy richness with nuances of leather and a cocoa-style fine grain tannin.
- R110 75 Cabernet Sauvignon Oakville California \$39  
This wine showcases wonderful notes of blueberry and fresh ripe cherries interwoven with subtle graphite and toasty oak. It is incredibly fragrant and beautifully concentrated, all the while maintaining great acidity and a wonderful long finish.
- R111 Crooked Row Merlot Napa Valley California \$29  
Soft rich and lush in the mouth. Flavors of cassis, chocolate and dark black fruits with a long rich finish.

## ***More of The Big Reds***

- R112 Cape Diamond Merlot Oregon \$38  
Aged in French oak barrels for over a year and bottled without filtration or fining, it has a lush texture that reveals itself layer by layer. Tantalizing rich black fruit aromas lead you to an exotic floral bouquet.  
Full-bodied on the palate, it possesses a beautiful balance of fruit and spice that make for a long, lovely finish.
- R113 Chateau Rouzan Ségla Margaux 1995 Bordeaux France \$79  
Consistently outstanding from cask. It is a classic vin de garde. Over a decade and a half of cellaring as made softened this bold Bordeaux into a complex layering of deep plumb, spicy, and cassis. Perfect with a well aged steak.
- R114 Chateau Branaire-Ducru Saint-Julien 2006 Bordeaux France \$122  
Medium red hue with excellent clarity. Nose of herbs, cherry and smoke. Spicy palet with good tannic structure.  
A robust wine with plenty to offer down the track. And after 5 years cellaring ....its reached it!
- R115 Chateau LaGrange Saint –Julien 2005 Bordeaux France \$142  
The color is rich and deep with purply red nuances. The nose is dominated by fresh red fruits with no over ripeness and by toasty notes. The fresh fruit, with a zest of citrus, coats the wood and tar/liquorice aromas.  
In the palate, the entry is well-structured and ample: the development remains virile, very generous and remarkably powerful: the very long finish offers sweetness without tanic harshness.
- R116 Chateau Batailley Grand Cru Classe Pauillac 2008 \$82  
Dark, a little perfumed, and with charcoal notes. An attractive palate, fresh and appealing, with fresh acids and firm ripe tannins. The fruit has nice aromatics, with slightly chewy character
- R118 Joel Gott 815 Cabernet Sauvignon California \$39  
"Dense aromatic fruit lies softly on the palate, enhanced with a velvety texture that

	culminates in a bittersweet mocha finish."

Aged in French oak for 14 months. Enjoy with steak, rack of lamb, or sipping with blue cheese.	\$37

## **Pinot Noir**

- R301 Cadre Pinot Noir “The Architects” Central Coast California \$71  
The wine’s purity is proof that a great Pinot does not have to come from a single vineyard. It’s bone dry and full-bodied in tannins, with complex flavors of black cherries, red currants, Dr. Pepper cola and exotic Asian spices. It was raised in one-year old oak, which gives smoky vanilla and caramel notes, in just the right proportion, to the fruit."
- R302 Grochau Cellers Pinot Noir “Commuter Cuvee” \$38  
The wine celebrates Portland as one of America's most avid and committed bike towns. Winemaker John Grochau (who is a sommelier at Portland's well known Higgen's restaurant) says the '09 Cuvee is: "...bright, fresh, vibrant, perfumed. I sacrificed some of my high end Pinots to make this vintage of the "Bike" especially good.  
It includes fruit from Domaine Coteau's vineyard."
- R303 Sticky Beak Pinot Noir Sonoma California \$44  
On the palate, we find a full velvety texture supporting vibrant flavors that mirror the aromas: black cherry and plum accented with notes of cinnamon and clove. The finish is long and very well structured
- R304 Sivas-Sonoma Pinot Noir California Coast \$38  
A bright red-purple color, our inaugural Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir opens with wild strawberry and raspberry aromas, complemented by background notes of violet, clove, vanilla, and molasses. Classic earthy, underbrush character unfolds on the palate, along with pomegranate and raspberry fruit.
- R305 David Bruce Pinot Noir Select Sonoma County \$39  
Aromas of red raspberries, black pepper, dark cherries, jasmine and a hint of lychee fruit. The 'russian river' style shows itself on the palate with lush blackberries and extracted red cherry fruit.
- R306 Firesteed Pinot Noir Oregon \$29  
The resulting wine’s aromas of strawberry and raspberry mingle with the distinct sensation of vanilla-cream. Good acid contributes to the balance and compliments the medium body. As the silky tannins fade on the inviting finish, the wine’s classic pinot aromas gather once again.
- R307 Patricia Green Pinot Noir Newberg Oregon \$71  
Aromas of sandalwood, incense, spice box, black cherry, and black raspberry lead to an elegant, medium-bodied wine with plenty of savory fruit, light tannin, and a medium-long, fruity finish.  
It will continue to blossom for another 1-2 years
- R308 O’Reilly’s Pinot Noir Oregon \$44  
The O’Reilly's 2009 Pinot Noir opens with a lovely nose of dried lavender and candied red fruit, with a hint of earth and pine. Bright red cherries fuse with jammy raspberry notes carrying through to a soft finish.
- R309 Orogeny Pinot Noir Russian River Valley California \$62

Bright Bing cherry, pomegranate and toffee notes on the nose, with a hint of spicy oak layered with ginger, nutmeg and coriander. The lush fruit continues to develop with time in the glass.

- R310 Jigsaw Pinot Noir Oregon **\$38**  
Oregon earth, rich plum and raspberry notes fill the bouquet of this vintage Jigsaw. Hints of spice and oak are in the background on the palate carried very well on the brightness of fruit with a long, dry finish.
- R311 Silverwing Pinot Noir Australia **\$29**  
Medium-bodied on the palate, with low acidity and lighter red fruits than on the nose.
- R312 Leese-Fitch Pinot Noir Sonoma California **\$32**  
Dark ruby in color, this Pinot Noir boasts aromas of wild strawberry, violets, dark plum, and vanilla spiked oak. Flavors reminiscent of dark plum, raspberry, tobacco leaf, cocoa nibs, and rhubarb finishing with a hint of earthy loam, black cherry, and toffee. The crisp acidity keeps you coming back for more
- R315 Leroy Pommard 1st Cru (red burgundy) Cote-d'Or Meursault Burgundy Fr **\$321**  
Vigorous color and a fabulous bouquet of sweet, ripe fruit, reminiscent of a reduction of cherry and plum. This is silky and mouth filling on the palate, with great balance and harmony. Though it's mature, it will hold at this stage for years.
- R319 Matello « Lazarus » Pinot Noir Willamette Valley Oregon **\$54**  
Tasted of strawberries and spice and everything nice. A micro whiff of savory herbs and wild fennel. A round wine that sings
- R503 Lucien Muzard et Fils Santenay Vieilles Vignes **\$42**  
An extremely fine Pinot Noir from one of Santenay's most respected producers. This is an elegant yet richly aromatic style, with deep, dark berry fruit flavours and cedarwood notes.

## ***Intriguing Red Varietals and Blends from around the World***

- R502 Apothic Red "Winemaker's Blend" Red Zinfandel, Syrah, Merlot **\$28**  
A captivating blend of three distinct grapes, with the dark fruit flavors of Syrah, brambly spice of Zinfandel, and a smooth elegance of Merlot
- R504 Borgonero Borgo Scopeto Italy **\$42**  
A very intense, almost impenetrable red in colour, its bouquet is broad, refined and captivating, with notes of leather and tobacco. To the palate it is extraordinarily structured, of great harmony and surprisingly soft.
- R505 Finca La Emperatriz Tempranillo Rioja Spain **\$36**  
Bright, brilliant color with concentrated and robust flavors with a finish that is round and full.
- R508 Lamole Chianti Classico Riserva Italy **\$40**  
Very ripe fruit aromas are backed up by classic field gladiolus florality, balsam and mint nuances, spiciness and sweet tobacco. Superb poise in the mouth, where structure, softness, acidity, extract and savouriness come together to perfection, taking you on to an aroma-rich finale
- R509 Clos Du Calvaire Chateauneuf du Pape France **\$56**  
Full-bodied and luscious. This wine displays nuances of black plums and berries.

R512	Sorrel Hermitage Vieilles Vignes France	\$93
	Bright red. Fresh red fruits on the nose, with smoky tobacco, herbs and dried flowers adding complexity. Tightly wound, mineral-drenched red berry and bitter cherry flavors soften with air, turning sweeter on the close	
R513	Langmeil <The Long Mile>Barossa “Hangin’ Snakes” Shiraz Viognier Australia	\$44
	Smooth and velvety, a sharp mouthful of mineral-accented red berry and floral flavors riding easily over the fine tannins, lingering on the finish.	
R515	Ironberry Cabernet-Shiraz-Merlot Blend Western Australia	\$28
	Smooth drink bursting with fruit, and just a bit on the dry side.	
R516	Juan Benegas Malbec Argentina	\$30
	Intense and concentrated. The core of fruit moves from fig and plum to rhubarb and prune, with a thickly textured, smoky finish.	
R517	Mano a Mano Tempranillo Spain	\$25
	Opaque purple-colored, it displays an expressive nose of Asian spices, blueberry, and black cherry compote. Dense, ripe, and intense, this pleasure-bent wine is a very good value that will drink well for another 4 years.	
R518	Le Gode Rosso di Montalcino Italy	\$42
	Bright ruby red with soft brown highlights. The nose is intense, recalling dry petals and fruits. On the palate, this wine is full-bodied, well balanced, and lingering with soft but firm tannins.	
R524	Ferraton “Pere & Fils” Cotes Du Rhones	\$37
	Garnet color with ruby reflects; very ripe red fruit; nicely structured with firm and meaty tannins; and aromas of small ripe fruit and spices.	
R527	Yalumba Bush Vine Grenache Barossa Valley Australia	\$30
	Bursting with savory berry and spice, a slightly higher alcohol level is well-balanced with fruit and oak, resulting in a unique red wine experience quite unlike that found with the more common varieties.	
R529	Rio Madre Rioja Graciano Spain	\$29
	Deep almost opaque in color, the exuberant aromas and luscious flavors of blackberries and cherries tells youth is is not a wine to be taken lightly but rather it should be enjoyed to its fullest	

## **West Coast Whites**

W101	Ferrari Carano Chardonnay Alexander Valley California	\$43
	Medium-light yellow; attractive, floral, pear and green apple aroma with a hint of honeysuckle; medium-full body; crisp, moderately rich, spicy, lemony, green apple flavors that are nicely balanced and not overly oaked; lingering aftertaste.	
W102	Cakebread Cellars Chardonnay Napa Valley California	\$82
	A classic Napa Chardonnay, this wine shows a fragrant varietal nose of white fruits and subtle vanilla with toasty nuances highlighting pear, pineapple and melon fruit flavors set in a supple, discreet oak structure.	

- W103 Annabella Chardonnay Napa Valley California \$26  
This wine has a beautiful straw color with subtle golden hues. This medium bodied fruit forward Chardonnay has bright flavors of lemon, apricot and fig. There are delicate pineapple and vanilla overtones that develop as the wine opens up.
- W108 Joel Gott Pinot Gris Oregon \$31  
White gold in color, has lemon, Lime and Orange blossom aromas and a rich flavor.  
The wine's bright minerality and acidity are balanced by soft floral aromas and a full bodied mouth-feel.
- W109 Shafer Chardonnay Napa Valley California \$91  
Full-bodied and graceful, ending with a pithy, leesy edge and a long, focused finish.
- W110 Eve Chardonnay Columbia Valley Washington State \$31  
Sinfully tempting...fresh, crisp, the perfume of sweet apple blossoms lures you into The Garden of Eden.  
Silky, soft, mouth filling deliciousness...take the first sip
- W111 Lockwood Sauvignon Blanc Monterrey California \$26  
Lockwood Sauvignon Blanc is a delightful wine style. Aromas of pomelo, green pear, and white peach fill the glass.  
On the palate, the wine is crisp with flavors of melon, stone fruit and citrus.
- W112 Elk Cove Vineyards Pinot Gris Willamette Valley Oregon \$29  
This wine shows traditional notes of citrus, grapefruit and leanness coming from the wine's minerality.  
Yet true to the Elk Cove Vineyards' style, there is richness in the mouth feel to give a full and satisfying balanced finish.
- W113 Chateau Montelena Chardonnay Napa Valley California \$94  
This is the Wine that made California Famous for Wine!! Famous for winning the white wine section of the historic "Judgement of Paris" wine competition. Chateau Montelena's Chardonnay went in competition with nine other wines from France under blind tasting and to the surprise of the French.....IT WON.
- W114 Plumpjack Chardonnay Reserve Napa Valley California \$91  
Primary aromas banana, spearmint, lemon zest and white peach which are followed by secondary aromas of rose water, Granny Smith apples and French vanilla.
- W115 Brick House Cascadia Chardonnay Oregon \$51  
This Oregon chardonnay offered nice acidity, good balance, and a delicious finish.
- W116 William Hill Chardonnay Central Coast California \$42  
Possesses a crisp, elegant, fresh, minimally oaked style in addition to subtle notions of tropical fruit, pear & citrus blossoms.

### ***International Chardonnay, Pinot Grigio, and Sauvignon Blanc***
